Olga M. Calvet, Senior Vice-President, Chief Financial Officer of Palmas Services, LLC was born November 4, 1949 in Havana, Cuba. A resident of Orlando since 1962, Olga graduated from Colonial High School and Orlando Junior College, and received her BSBA degree with a major in accountancy from the University of Central Florida in 1971.

After college, she joined the international accounting firm of Seidman and Seidman, CPA's at their Orlando office. She continued her career at Laventhol and Horwath, CPA's, eventually establishing her own CPA firm in 1979.

After selling her accounting practice in 1986, she became the CFO of Palmas Services, LLC, a participant at Walt Disney World and operator of restaurant and lounge locations at EPCOT and Disney's Coronado Springs Resort. Currently serving as Senior Vice President, and Chief Financial Officer of Palmas, she oversees the financial administration of the company, which encompasses the areas of internal audit, accounting, taxation and compliance. The company currently employs approximately 450 people and has revenues of \$46 million annually. Palmas has previously been included in Hispanic Business magazine's Top 500 Hispanic Companies.

Olga is a member of the Florida Institute of Certified Public Accountants, and of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants.

Olga is married to Cesar, President of the CNL Bank Latin Banking Group. They have two daughters, Cristina (UCF '01, '03), principal of CCH Marketing & Events, Inc. and Alexandra (UCF '09), who recently began her career with Palmas' subsidiary Springs Food Services, LLC.
